Safe fundraising procedures

Fundraising procedures to safely fundraise by the COVID traffic light system



Green light

At Green COVID-19 is contained. We all need to be ready in case COVID-19 reappears in our community.

- At Green, Street Collectors must stay at home if they are sick. Street Collectors should:
- > Try to maintain at least one metre physical distance from people they don't know.
- > Continue contact tracing. QR COVID-19 tracing posters will be available at each location.
- > Have hand sanitiser available.

Orange light

At Orange COVID-19 is contained but the risk of community transmission remains. Street collections are permitted at Orange.

Play it safe. Reduce the risk of COVID-19 transmission:

- > Street Collectors with a cold or flu like symptoms must stay away.
- All volunteers and/or staff that are street collecting must be given a COVID-19 health and safety briefing before collecting. This will be arranged by your local street collection coordinator.
- No presentation material or collateral is to be given to members of the public. ASB QR GIV2 stickers to be given out only at Green.
- > Please do not approach a member of the public who appears to be over 70 years of age.

Contact Tracing

- You must have and clearly display QR code posters and encourage the public to use them.
- Keep a schedule and contact tracing records at each location.
- Where practically possible, try and stay in the same pairs of collectors throughout the week to limit the potential risk of transferring the virus across more people (e.g. site managers, shop owners, staff, and members of the public that they interact with).

ASB is committed to meeting its obligations under the Anti-Money Laundering and Countering Financing of Terrorism Act 2009 (AML/CFT Act).

These obligations require ASB to adequately identify anyone making cash deposits through its branch network, including those individuals depositing funds raised for the St John Annual Appeal into your region's St John New Zealand's ASB bank account.

Please ensure you take a form of photo ID (e.g., New Zealand Passport, New Zealand Driver's License) with you when depositing any funds collected for the St John Annual Appeal/Annual Street Collection.

AML process for in-branch deposit of Annual Appeal funds:

> Put all funds raised in a standard ASB deposit bag.

Note: ASB is no longer supplying charity deposit bags so get in early to get your standard deposit bags from your local ASB branch. Please keep a record of the banking bag numbers for reference.

Drop the deposit bag to the ASB branch staff at the counter. You will be required to provide one form of photo ID to complete the transaction.
