The realities of operating in Christchurch in 2012

- ▶ The average job cycle time in Christchurch has increased from 60 to 80 minutes.
- ▶ The increase is due to a combination of factors, including the condition of roads and the type of calls St John is responding to.
- ▶ Since the earthquake we have seen an increase in breathing and heart problems in Christchurch.
- ▶ Five St John facilities in Christchurch remain closed for safety reasons, including Wainoni station and St Asaph Street station.
- ▶ Our former administration offices at Hereford Street are in the red zone. Our administration team has just started working from facilities in Orchard Road.
- ▶ St John has raised approximately \$4 million to repair and replace equipment, and to be ready for any possible future events.
